Detailed measurements of up to thirty-five body metrics are taken.

The first draft of the gown is called the "toile". Made of similar material, it is used for the first fitting to verify the design and measurements, and to ensure a perfect fit. Adjustments are made to the fit and the style lines as required.

During the final fitting, the bridal party can share the excitement and be pampered in our exclusive lounge while the bride puts on her couture gown for the first time.
